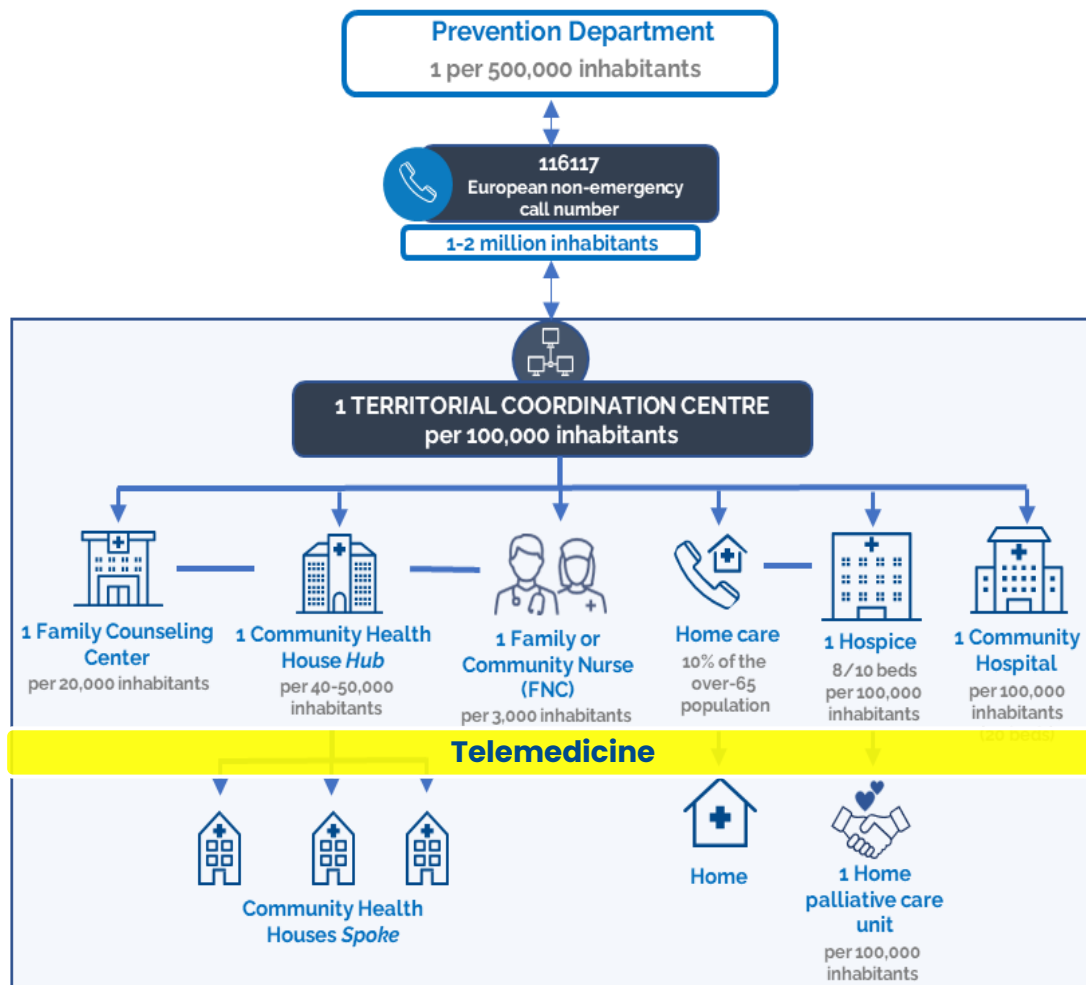

# Primary care reform



The EU-funded National Recovery and Resilience Plan (NRRP) promotes an ambitious reform agenda. Mission 6 “health” of the NRRP includes one reform about the:

**“Definition of a new organisational model of the Territorial Healthcare network”** ratified by **Ministerial Decree No. 77** of 23 May 2022.

The reform redesigns territorial healthcare introducing new **proactive care models** to enhance public health and **digital innovation**.

Main funding:

- Telemedicine 1,5 billion €
- Home care 2.72 billion €

# Telemedicine

€ 1,5 billion NRRP investment

## National Telemedicine Platform € 250 million

Functionalities tested on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023:

- Governance and validation of solutions
- Clinical workflow
- Terminology encoding and standards
- Outcome evaluation

Full operation of NTP is linked to the publication of the Ministerial Decree on Telemedicine and to the implementation of the interoperability layer with eHealth Record (FSE) and the Health Data System (EDS).

## Telemedicine Services € 750 million

Regional Telemedicine Infrastructure (software) to be acquired through the tender led by Lombardy Region:

- Televisit
- Teleconsultation
- Teleassistance
- Telemonitoring for diabetes, neurology, respiratory disease, cardiology and oncology.

**!** Awarded 8<sup>th</sup> May 2024

Workstations and logistics (hardware), to be acquired through the tender led by Puglia Region.

**!** Contracting within 30th June 2024

*Decree 21 September 2022 – Functional requirements and standards of service of telemedicine services*

*Decree 30 September 2022 – Minimum services purchase and guidelines adoption for telemedicine services*

*Decree 28 September 2023 – Resources allocation*



# Telenursing

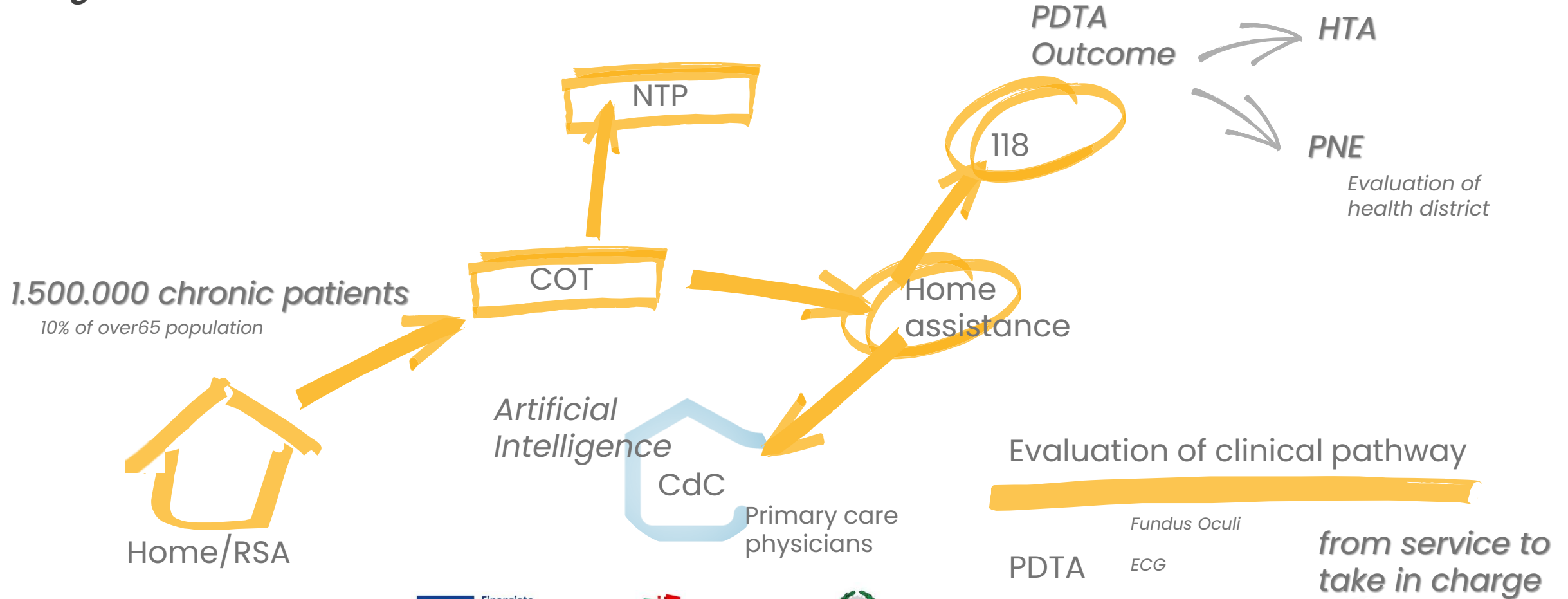
*Telemedicine service that delivers nursing care (e.g. health monitoring, assessment, promotion, prevention, and education) directly to the patient's home, through digital health tools.*



- To improve proactive, personalized, and proximity care.
- Home as a privileged place of care, especially for people with chronic diseases.
- To diminish unnecessary hospital admissions.
- To bridge the gap in geographic access to healthcare services.
- To increase patient satisfaction, safety, and empowerment.
- By mid-2026, the NRRP goal is to reach at least 200.000 people with telemedicine services and to treat at home at least 10% of the over 65 (842,000 elderly people).
